

Cautions for using the beach (recreation, fishing, surfing etc.)

Waves and rivers can alter the state and terrain of this beach. Please be careful when using the beach in the following areas!

Caution 1: Sand Cliffs

Do not approach sand cliffs formed by rivers and waterways or coastal erosion

Erosion caused by waves, as well as rivers and waterways, can cause sand cliffs to form. Do not approach them.



Caution 2: Seawalls

Do not climb on top of seawalls

For your safety, do not climb seawalls under any circumstances.

Caution 3:

Wave-dissipating block

Do not approach wave-dissipating blocks

Wave-dissipating blocks that have become unstable due to waves or earthquakes, as well as blocks covered with sand and surrounding sandy areas are at risk of collapsing. Do not approach them.
